Your Opportunity For Service

By warmly greeting visitors and members of the congregation to our worship services you are creating a friendly and inviting impression, showing all that their fellowship is welcomed, wanted, and encouraged here at Holy Cross.

The Basics

- ✘ Dress appropriately for the occasion. Remember that you are the first person people will meet upon entering the building, so you want to make a good impression.
- ✘ Arrive 20 minutes prior to the scheduled service.
- ✘ Wear your name badge.
- ✘ Station yourself inside one of the main doors of the church, but a few steps inside so as to allow people a moment to orient themselves as they enter.
- ✘ Help to open the doors for those coming to worship, if needed or desired.
- ✘ Greet each person with a warm smile and/or handshake.
- ✘ If they identify themselves as a visitor, escort them to the sanctuary and provide them with a service folder. Notify the **Lay Minister on duty**, and a Pastor, if available. Consider providing them with your name, phone number and e-mail address, should they have any questions after their visit is complete.
